

**Faith Connections on Mental Illness** (FCMI), a Chapel Hill-based interfaith non-profit, was the number one fundraising team out of 101 total teams in NAMIWalks 2018. Held in Raleigh, NC on April 14, 2018, twenty-two registered FCMI walkers collected \$8,950. FCMI's top individual fundraiser – Geetha Balagopal – was also the event's top fundraiser out of 1,145 participants, receiving \$4,150 in donations.
